




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Limudei Kodesh- Outstanding Torah Learning

At Mesivta Emes L'Yaakov, our goal is to give our students the skills they need to be self-sufficient learners. Our system is designed to produce a young man who has the motivation to continue learning once he has left yeshiva, the skills to learn independently, and the confidence and clarity to develop his own insights and perspectives in Torah.

We do this by maintaining a low Rebbe-Talmid ratio, focusing on developing critical thinking skills, and giving interactive, dynamic shiurim that promote independent thought. Additionally, our Bais Medrash bochurim serve as role models, night seder chavrusos, and “big brothers” to our high school boys.

Our dedicated Rabbeim are also mentors and role models who work to connect with their talmidim personally. Their love and dedication creates a fertile environment for talmidim to thrive academically, emotionally and spiritually.

What do dorm students do after school/off time?




